The Village of Luck's new 7,000 square foot library and museum is located in the downtown area. The design includes a plaza at the main entrance of the one-story building leading to a distinctive rotunda with vaulted ceiling and clear story windows. The library and museum areas share a meeting room and restrooms. Exterior materials are cultured stone veneer with a stone cap along the lower portion of the building and a stucco finish on the upper portion of the building.

Cedar Corporation was the architect, engineer and landscape architect for the project. Fundraising efforts were conducted by members of the library board and the local historical committee. Cedar Corporation prepared an application for Community Development Block Grant funding, which was awarded \$100,000 from the State of Wisconsin.
