

Ordinance No. # 2009-A

An Ordinance regarding the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan for the Village of Woodville, St. Croix County, Wisconsin.

The Village Board of the Village of Woodville, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Sec. 60.22(3) Wis. Stats. and Sec. 62.23(2) and (3), Wis. Stats., the Village of Woodville is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sec. 66.1001(1)(a) and Sec. 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.

Section 2. The Village Board of the Village of Woodville, Wisconsin has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by Sec. 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats.

Section 3. The Plan Commission of the Village of Woodville, by a majority vote recorded in its official minutes dated November 2, 2009 has adopted a resolution recommending to the Village Board the adoption of the document entitled A Village of Woodville Comprehensive Plan 2009 - 2029@ containing all of the elements specified in Sec. 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.

Section 4. The Village has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance in compliance with the requirements of Sec. 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats. on December 8, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. at the Woodville Village Hall, 124 Main Street, Woodville, WI.

Section 5. The Village Board of the Village of Woodville, Wisconsin does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, A Village of Woodville Comprehensive Plan 2009 - 2029@ pursuant to Sec. 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Village Board and publication as required by law.
